Please pray for the group, mums with different worries and levels of exhaustion. For each to enjoy and build up positive relationships in the family. Pray for a mum who is seriously ill, her family and wee one. Pray for the volunteers that we might show God's love for each family and be sensitive to the different needs and make new people welcome.
Fri. 26/02	Praise God that several children from both Chatterboxes and Newhaven Church will be attending the Scripture Union Scotland Edinburgh Schools Weekend. Pray that the children would meet with God in a real way; would deepen their relationships with one another; and that Cassie and Christine can keep up with them! Mon. 29/02	Fair trade fortnight. This years theme The BIG fair trade breakfast, sit down for breakfast stand up for farmers. Which asks us to reflect on where our favourite breakfast food come from and how the producers are treated. Fairtrade now reaches over 1.5 million farmers and workers across the globe ensuring fair pay and working conditions, but there is still a long way to go. Wed. 10/02	Lord, give us humility to serve others and give us the love, which finds significance and identity in you. From <i>Encounter with God</i> .		
Thur. 11/02	Pray for the making of plans for Easter. The Mission and Outreach group will be planning for services and reflection on Good Friday. It is intended to repeat the prayer stations. Sat. 13/02	Pray for Trinity Academy as chaplaincy is begun under the direction of Alex McAspurren of North Leith Parish Church. Pray that the team, of which Cassie will be involved, will be able serve the school in a way that demonstrates Christ's love for them.		
Sun. 14/02	Help us in our reading of the Bible. Gives us wisdom in our understanding and interpretation and perseverance in our study. May we allow the word to fashion our lives and to be open to God's leading.		
Mon. 15/02	Pray for families as they take a rest from the school diary for the February break. Pray that they would be able to rest and enjoy time with one another.		
		Tues. 16/02	Pray for the work of Scottish Bible Society as they promote the reading of the bible, and for Bible world and the many schools that will take part in its programme this year. Pray for each child that their time on board will make an impact on their young lives.
