Stewardship – Using your Time and Talents

Role: Church Brunch – Cook

Background info: On the 1st Sunday of certain months of the year the Church puts on a Brunch after the service for all who want to stay. The Brunch consists of Bacon Rolls, Cheese rolls, Cakes, juice, tea and coffee.

Duties: Turn up at 9:30am. Put on the Dishwasher, Oven and Hot Water. Cook the bacon and keep in tin foil in oven to keep warm. Butter the rolls but keep 6 unbuttered in case people don't like butter. Put cakes out on plates. Put cheese on plate. Keep Gluten free Cakes and Rolls separate. Get the Tea, Coffee & Juice out from the after Church Fellowship supply box. Fill the flasks with Hot water, the tea can be made just before the food is taken through. Make up juice.

When & How Often: Brunch is on the 1st Sunday of February, March, April, May, June, September, October, November and December. There is a rota and you volunteer for the Sundays you are available.

Who would I be working with?: There are usually a minimum of 2 people in the kitchen doing the Cooking.

What skills would I need?: Being organised. Being comfortable in a Kitchen and working a cooker. Knowing how to cook bacon.
