Stewardship – Using your Time and Talents

Role: Helping at Holiday Club with Crafts

Background info: Usually the 1st week of the School Summer Holidays we run a Holiday Club. This is for P1-7 children from Victoria, Trinity Primaries and the community, it is run under the banner of Scripture Union. We work with the Ministers and Congregations of Leith Baptist and City on a Hill Churches to run this club. It runs every morning from the Monday to the Friday. Children arrive from 10 and it lasts till 12:30pm followed by free family lunch.

Duties:

There will be 2 evening meetings with training at them which are important to attend if at all possible.

We start at 9am for devotions, have lunch after the club with the families and finish at 1pm after a brief.

We need people to set up the crafts in the other rooms in advance of the children arriving and then tidy them up and prepare for the next craft. You may be involved in helping the children with more difficult crafts or finishing for them if they run out of time.

When & How Often: Annually the 1st week of the school holidays every morning. If you can, it's helpful to be able to do the whole week but if not at least 2 -3 mornings but if this is not feasible you can choose to do just the ones you can manage.

Who would I be working with?: Children and other helpers in the Club.

What skills would I need?:

Like organising crafts and tidying up

Is Disclosure Required Y/N?: Yes from Scripture Union- if you want to be involved with the Children. PVG from Scripture Union and application form would need to be in by the end of April. If you are just involved in setting up and tidying up then no PVG is required but that would mean you could not be in the room with the children at all. So it's up to you how you want to be involved.
