Stewardship – Using your Time and Talents

Role: Helping in the kitchen at our Inflatables Day in March.

Background info: One Saturday (usually in March) we hire a Bouncy Castle, Bungy Run, Large games etc. and invite the children from the local schools and organisations to come along and have fun.

Duties: We split the day into different sessions organised by age group. Each session for the children shift lasts 1 hour 15 mins. You would be expected to arrive 15 mins before each session so for a helper, the session would last 1 hour 30 mins.

We need lots of Juice and it has to be available constantly for each group. As well as juice for the Children we provide tea & coffee for the helpers and Parents who may stay while their children are there.

You will be asked to prepare the drinks and clear up after it is finished.

When & How Often: One Saturday in March. As we split the day into different sessions for the children lasting 1 hour 15 mins. You would be expected to arrive 15 mins before each session so, for a helper, the session would last 1 hour 30 mins. You can choose the sessions you are available for.

Who would I be working with?: Other helpers in the kitchen.

What skills would I need?:

Like preparing, serving food and working in a team and in a kitchen.
